SARATOGA STEVE reserved between rivals during the opening half, angled outward before commencing to rally in upper stretch, took off in earnest under a vigorous hand ride, continued to make good progress after being switched to the stick, finally securing the advantage a right near the wire to prevail. BARREL OF LOVE off the inside, angled to the middle of the course after entering the stretch and came home with good courage. FIDDLER'S CHAPARITO broke alertly from the gate to establish command, set quick factions well clear of the competition while racing towards the inside, emerged from the furlong grounds still maintaining a comfortable advantage, was put to the test by the top pair late, yielded, but held on willingly for show honors. TOO TOUGH JAKE saved ground and displayed a good kick during the stretch run. DOUGIE chased the leader from the outside until the quarter pole before backing off. RUNAWAY JIM forwardly placed three wide for a half, tired. JERICO RULES raced three wide and faltered. AMERICAN CHANT was outrun. NIGHT IN SEATTLE had brief foot.
