HALF METAL JACKET unhurried during the opening stages, was kept well off the inside, began to to advance forward, lightly coaxed along, after reaching the turn, still kept deliberately off the inside, was put to stronger encouragement as he entered the lane four wide, closed steadily during the run through the furlong grounds under persistent left handed flailing, was switched over to right handed whipping after drawing along side the leader, wore down that one in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away while being kept busy. BIRD RUN bobbled at the break, battled for the lead from the outside until the quarter pole, was overhauled by FLAT BOLD nearing the top of the lane, but came back willingly to out finish that rival for the place. FLAT BOLD stalked the front runners from the outside under a strong hold, moved for the lead when ready under the same strong hold as the field neared the quarter pole, successfully wrested command, maintained a clear advantage under a drive with a furlong to go, was joined by the eventual winner, failed to resist, readily yielding and weakened thereafter. I AIN'T NO SAINT lacked the necessary stretch response. FAMOUS PATRIOT off the inside, offered no bids. GRIDIRON battled for the lead along the inside for six furlongs and faltered.
