FIGHT FOR V L T'S patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, moved up to issue a challenge coming to the quarter pole, was driven to a comfortable advantage by the sixteenths pole before being geared down in the late stages. IRON LOU took the inside route until the quarter pole, was placed in the three path at the head of the stretch and came home willingly to secure second. POWER BLAST chased between rivals on the turn, made no serious bids en route for the show. KARAKORUM ON BLACK rated in the overland route to the quarter pole, had no rally. STYLISH FELLA bumped with CAMIE'S HOT at the start, established command and was angled over to the rail, set the pace from there under the watchful eye of the top one, was put to a stern test by that opponent as the twosome headed into the stretch and succumbed. I GOT SWAGGER underwent a four wide pursuit between rivals and tired. CAMIE'S HOT made contact with STYLISH FELLA leaving the starting gate, raced three wide on the turn, with foes on either side, gave way after going a half. JOEY'S CHANCE appeared uncomfortable in tight between rivals, dropped back after being checked coming to the five-eighths pole, got going soon afterwards, gave chase from the outside between rivals until the quarter pole before backing away.
