IRISH LAUGHTER contested the pace along the inside, responded when roused and drew away under a drive. SAFARI was bumped after the start, was unhurried early, rallied wide approaching the stretch, could not get to the winner and continued on to hold the place. SEAQUARIUS was bumped after the start, dropped back early, raced five wide and finished well outside. DREAMING THE BLUES was bumped after the start, was outrun early, rallied four on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. WARNING SIGNAL raced inside and lacked a rally. MISTICAL FASTNESS contested the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. STOP AND SEA contested the pace while three wide and tired. VALATIE argued the pace while between rivals and tired after a half mile. TACTICAL STAN raced wide and tired.
