THE PLOT THICKENS broke sharply to establish command, galloped off to a commanding lead during the run around the opening bend, while not being asked for speed, continued along uncontested towards the inside, still under rating tactics, until the quarter pole, was put to hand encouragement after entering the lane, left the furlong grounds still comfortably in front and held sway while being kept busy to the finish line. MILLENNIUM JET chased the runaway pacesetter from the outside from the get go but proved no match during the stretch run. GOLLY DAY three wide around the far turn, was outfinished for place honors. RAVEN'S CHOICE saved ground throughout and had no rally. SO IT GOES failed to menace. PAVLOV'S DOG underwent a wide journey and never posed a threat. ROYAL LORD was outrun. KICK UP YOUR HEELS saved ground to no avail.
