Footnotes

AIKENITE well reserved during the opening half, began to advance into contention from the outside on the turn, came five wide into the lane, began to rally to earnest after being set down, fought his way to the lead by the furlong marker, and edged away while kept under a strong drive to the end. SHREWD ONE at the back of the pack early, sped past rivals into a striking position with a four wide bid, after entering the turn, was put to a drive turning for home, came in a bit, momentarily, approaching the eighth pole, putting KHALIFA in tight for a stride or two, was taken off that rival and placed on a truer course in short order, continued on well thereafter to earn place honors. WINAHOLIC between rivals on the turn, displayed a mild kick to be along for the show. KHALIFA rated stalking the pacesetter from the three path, brushed with that rival in upper stretch, steadied after finding himself in tight quarters briefly near the furlong marker, had no serious offering thereafter. HOPOE saved ground and failed to menace. COCALERO took the overland route and tired. SAFETY CHECK quickly established command, cut the pace from the two path under the watchful eye of KHALIFA, brushed with that rival after succumbing in upper stretch and gave way. A claim of foul lodged by the rider of KHALIFA against the rider of the runner up alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
