INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and start fees. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Cup nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Three-year-olds, 117 lbs., Older, 123. Non-winners of a Grade One or a Grade Two on the turf since October 1, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 on the turf in 2010, 5 lbs.; four races on the turf, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, June 5, 2010 with 28 Nominations.

LADY SHAKESPEARE outrun while bringing up the back of the pack for this foursome, continued to lag behind for three-quarters, began to pick up the pace after being placed under encouragement on the second turn, found her best stride after turning for home, gobbled up real estate during the run through the furlong grounds, surged past the threesome up front to take charge leaving the sixteenth pole and drew off under good handling. CHANGING SKIES (IRE) reserved under a good hold for seven furlongs, was given her cue in upper stretch, finished willingly in the late stages to garner place honors. AVE (GB) rated stalking the pacesetter during the early stages, was lightly coaxed along to remain just off that one's hind quarters around the far turn, was set down after entering the stretch, put pressure on the leader during the next furlong, but failed to sustain the bid. DAVERON (GER) quickly established command, was well rated until the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch and gave way. GOZZIP GIRL stumbled badly at the break, losing the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
