DIANNEOESTHEBOOKS broke well to establish early command in the two path down the backside and around the far turn while well rated ,was given some rein to work with coming to the quarter pole as a host of pursuers built up just in behind, was put to a drive by the eighth pole and stayed on grimly to preserve the win then was pulled up and vanned off after the finish. WEE FREUDIAN three wide off an early pace dispute , closed in on the leader while taking the overland route around the far turn,sat perched four wide at the top of the lane was asked for run at the quarter pole rallied down the lane to just miss and settled for second best. COOKS FOREST out sprinted in the early going, raced along the inside while saving ground around the far turn, swung out five wide at the quarter pole and closed well along the center of the stretch to procure the show in a three way photo. RAECINJASIN brushed the gate at the start settled in midpack ,came under a long drive from midway on the turn and kept pace before tiring while never threatening the top. READING GROUP allowed to settle early, swung six wide at the quarter pole and came up empty. VALID OCEAN PASS stalked the leader until the top of the lane and steadily tired thereafter.
