LONGHAMMER well reserved, brought up the back of the pack, approached the quarter pole, with the rider sitting with a firm grip on the reins, was put to encouragement and fanned from the four path into upper stretch, took off with a strong kick once straightened away, latched on to the runner up shortly after leaving the furlong grounds, was battling head to head with that opponent as both went by SUPER DOC in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, slowly edged away from HYPER thereafter to prove best. HYPER sat reserved in the two path for the opening half, was placed three wide leaving midpoint on the turn, and asked for some run, in preparation for the stretch drive, charged towards the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, went by, with the top one, directly to his outside on nearly terms, showed good determination, but got denied. SUPER DOC loosely stalked the early pacesetter, began to close the gap departing the backstretch, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, blew by a spent HAMMOCK to take over nearing the furlong marker, but with several rivals bearing down hard, yielded the lead with about a sixteenth to go, but held well to salvage the show. GIOPI (IRE) took the inside route, was moving willingly when forced to steady, stuck behind the tiring former pacesetter, maneuvered around that opponent a few strides later and flashed belated interest. GIARIXA three wide around the bend, had no rally. COOKRAM ROCK raced along the outside and tired. HAMMOCK sped off from the competition leaving the gate, set the fractions on a loose lead from the inside, felt a rush of heavy pressure coming to the eighth pole, and quickly succumbed.
