Footnotes

RACE TO URGA raced within range between rivals for most of the way around the turn, was placed three wide issuing a challenge for the lead approaching the top of the lane, surged by under intermittent urging to emerge from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, safely held it, ridden out during the last eighth. ABACO lagged behind while saving ground, slipped into the two path late on the turn, turned for home two wide and already under encouragement, hesitated for a stride before splitting rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, was taken out a bit wider soon afterwards, and came home with good late foot en route for the place. AN ABSOLUTE TEN rode the pocket until the quarter pole and got out finished. STYLE SQUAD saved ground and lacked the needed response. SPLENDID disputed the pace from the two path until the quarter pole and gave way. NOW SMILE angled four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty for the stretch run. WINERY forwardly placed in the opening stages, offered some resistance before being taken back a bit upon reaching the backstretch, underwent a three wide pursuit, stayed within striking distance for nearly three-quarters, folded. L'ETOILE BLEUE (GER) argued for the lead from the inside and faltered. ARCH ROYAL three wide for most of the way around the turn, was five wide by upper stretch, tired.
