WIRED BRYAN in slightly at the break, was pulled off the nearest opponent before any significant contact could be made..struck the front to gain a narrow advantage shortly afterwards, competed the lively opening fraction facing pressure from another pair, one of those being his stablemate, began to edge away approaching the end of the bend, was a few strides into the stretch before getting called upon, kicked well clear, kept to brisk encouragement to the end. IRISH SWEEPSTAKES broke outward a couple of steps as the field was sent on its way, was stacked four wide at the top of the turn but did most his chasing of the winner from the three path, proved no match while comfortably clear of the others for the place. BLUE COLLAR CAT lost his footing coming out of the gate and bobbled slightly, was slow to settle into stride, raced along the outside, was swung five wide, the widest of all into the stretch, got straightened away and got outfinished. ADAMS NOTE briefly between foes in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, tired. I'M GONNA FLIP pulled on the bit and reached out greenly during the short run leading up to the turn, raced from off the inside and more professionally around it, ducked over to be nearer the rail after entering the stretch, backed away. CAROLINIAN put to some hand urging at the start, got outthustled by the winner for command, sat forwardly placed along the rail in the initial stages, angled outward while getting asked for run a short distance before arriving at the quarter pole, tipped outward until a little past the four path in upper stretch, gave way.
