Footnotes

FREE BRAVE three wide just off pace in hand, angled five wide for home roused, rallied into contention a furlong out, battled with DUAL CITIZEN to the wire and just got up in the final strides to prevail. DUAL CITIZEN tracked just off the inside within aim, got set down spinning three wide into the stretch, rallied to seize command a furlong out with the aforementioned rival breathing down his neck, fought head to head to the finish and was nailed in the last jumps. SAM'S BUCK just off the inside in mid pack, got roused at the head of the lane, rallied to split foes a furlong out kicking on belatedly for the show honors. GAMBLIN FEVER saved ground down along the hedge settled in mid pack, cut the corner roused into the lane, had to pause briefly near the furlong grounds lacking clearance until SAM'S BUCK went on by, angled out slightly offering up a mild bid for the last major share. BARZINI just off the inside

towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled five wide for home, offered up a mild kick by mostly tired rivals in the late stages. J W BLUE off half a beat slow, saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick by tired rivals in the lane. NON STOP settled just off the pace tracking from just off the inside in hand, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild bid to the final furlong before weakening in the late stages. MATT AND JESSE three wide in mid pack, angled four wide into upper stretch roused and offered no response. ELDER SKATESMAN hustled from the start, was forwardly placed three wide within range, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired in the drive. RANGEY on the pace in hand inside, cut the corner into the stretch set down for the drive, got headed nearing the final furlong and faltered. DEVOTED WILDCAT rank early on resisting the restraint of the rider out of the dog legged turn into the backside, settled in mid pack two to three wide, faded in the far turn losing position to the quarter pole and made no impact. HANDSOME HARBOR three wide towards the rear urged along from three furlongs out, trailed.
