HOLY ENDEAVOR was put to encouragement to work his way to the front, settled near the two path while arguing to maintain command, came under intensified pressure heading for the quarter pole and got asked for his best, gave it digging in stubbornly to fend off the runner up. STORM PURSUIT assumed a forward position right from the start, pressed the issue towards the three path, doing so under a firm hold for a good portion of the opening half, crept up to increase his presence coming to the end of the bend, got called upon, continued onward willingly to the wire, but wasn't up to the task of reeling in the top one. GINGER'S JOE came inward bumped with the nearest opponent, fanned into the five path coming to the three-sixteenths pole, closed well en route for the show. FREUD'S DEBUT was taken hold after getting bumped from between rivals with solid impact at the start, was quickly sent over to the rail and rode it almost all the way to the quarter pole, was angled outward approaching that station until four wide by the head of the stretch, failed to fire

appreciably when called upon. TRICKY SLAM was squeezed back after being from both sides at the break, loped along down the backstretch slightly of the inside, swung outward until about six wide in upper stretch, displayed some energy but had to settle for minor spoils. OUT OF YOUR MIND bobbed after getting jostled amongst rivals at the start, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled four wide, failed to make an impact. WAR HITCH came outward, bumping with FREUD'S DEBUT and playing a major role in the creation of some crowding right afterwards, chased the front runners at a considerable distance from off the rail for a half before backing away. D'ORO DANCER forwardly placed while between rivals, tired. CALL UP THE CHIEF four wide at the three-eighths pole, had no rally. KELTIC FIGHTER three wide midway on the turn, folded. CHICS PALACE under encouragement while keeping pace from the pocket, faded.
