CHAYSEN' ALEX along the hedge during the early going, was taken out to the two path at the half mile pole, sat reserved towards the back, angled outward in upper stretch, commenced his rally when given his cue, then closed with a rush down the center of the course to prove best. DUNVEGAN tracked the pacesetter from the pocket under a firm hold, bided his time during the run around the bend, while still not being asked for his best, angled outward when the opportunity presented itself, approaching the quarter pole, responded well when called upon, poked a head in front at the furlong marker, still maintained a clear advantage with a sixteenth remaining, but was powerless to forestall the top one's powerful late burst of speed. CORONATION DAY unhurried during the initial half, came four wide into the stretch and displayed a good kick to grab the show. CIRES within striking distance, was attempting a three wide move on the far turn, when bothered and carried out by the ill-fated rival nearing the quarter pole, recovered in quick fashion, closed with good courage during the run through the furlong grounds, but could not sustain the bid. SENOR ENRICO raced along the outside and had a mild rally. FREUDIAN STORM away quickly from the starting gate, carved the pace from the inside, yielded at the eighth pole and tired steadily thereafter. FIERY REBEL saved

ground and was no factor. BATON ROUGE hustled early, was through after completing a half. INHALER broke through the gate prior to the start, stalked the pacesetter from the outside before tragically breaking down nearing the head of the stretch. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the incident at the quarter pole before the result was declared official.
