### Footnotes

SUN DANCE MOON chased the front runners three wide, was put to a long drive, commencing midway around the bend, forged his way to clear advantage by midstretch, then held sway while being kept busy to the end. GRAYSONIA sat well positioned along the inside under a good hold during the initial half, angled outward turning for home into an eventual traffic jam, was forced to check coming to the eighth pole when the pathway to the finish line was shut down, altered course outward, resumed his rally, finishing with good courage to garner place honors. SIX CLICKS bumped shortly after the gate sprung open, sat reserved off the inside, came four wide into the lane and displayed a good kick to take the show. PERCUSIONIST (ARG) away well from the starting gate, set the pace towards the inside, facing mild pressure from JOCKEY RIDGE, surrendered the front soon after entering the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. JOCKEY RIDGE attended the pace from the two path for a half before backing off. SOUND CHASER bumped after the start, was outrun. LIQUIDITY EVENT came in at the start, bobbed, then bumped with SIX CLICKS, losing the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
