Footnotes

SHEZA HEARTBREAKER one of a cluster of horses bunched up a short distance past the starting gate, took the worse of it than most, getting taken in hand as a result of being in a bit too tight, got going again, paused in hand again three wide in vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole coming up in close proximity to another foe, entered the stretch and was let out, paused in hand for a third and final time briefly placed behind the front runners, altered course inward and unleashed a rail run from the three-sixteenths pole to poke a head down in front soon afterwards, kicked away and held sway, driving. STRATEGIC MISSILE sat forwardly placed three wide on the turn, was asked for run and closed in on the leader leaving the five-sixteenths marker, got hooked in a spirited tussle with another pair near the top of the lane, battled with vigor to the end but had to settle for the place. SPUN SILKY started the chase on the leader from the three path at the top of the turn, scooted by ORIGINAL KITTEN and moved closer to the rail at the midway point, entered the stretch and vied for command with the first two finishers for much of the way through the furlong grounds, failed to keep up in the final furlong and weakened into the show slot. SPOOKY KITTEN put into the four path at the three-eighths pole, flattened out. RAIN FOREST three wide departing the backstretch, lacked the needed response. HEIRESSOFTHECROWN tipped outward to be six wide at the three-sixteenths pole, made no headway. HOUSE ON TOILSOME got brushed at the break, saved ground during the opening stages, fanned outward until near the seven path by midstretch, made no impact.

RESOUNDINGLY in tight quarters, was checked shortly after the start, saved ground and failed to menace. ORIGINAL KITTEN applied pressure on the leader for a half before giving way. ALPHA J out sharply at the start, was pulled away from the nearest opponent but not before making light contact, vied for command for nearly a half, fell back quickly thereafter and got eased. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
