**Footnotes**

LOVE MY MONDAYS left the starting gate alertly to assume command, showed the way from the two path while keeping something in reserve, extended his margin after being let out a notch at the three-sixteenths pole, then continued to draw off during the final furlong under a vigorous hand ride. FEDERAL DEPOSIT, steadied slightly after breaking outward a bit, was unhurried while racing off the inside, gradually advanced towards the leaders during the run around the bend, proved to be no match for the top one during the stretch run but continued on well to get up for the place. AIR ATTACK saved ground throughout and lacked the necessary stretch response. SLIGHT FEVER was bumped after lunging at the start, failed to reach a contending position. JOHNNY BE ANGRY chased the winner three wide for a half before fading. LANDON'S STAR hit the gate at the start, checked sharply a few strides later, trailed the field during the opening half, before improving his position by mainly weak rivals during the stretch run. BENNINGTON STATION bumped at the start, was never a threat. BIG LUMMOX three wide, was urged on the turn and tired. JET BLUE DREAM had brief foot, was eased heading for the lane, walking across the wire for the final check.
