### Footnotes

TRUE BLUE NATION broke on top and shook free to grab the early advantage, was sent over to the inside, steadily edged away the frantically-handled CHASE MY TAIL during the run around the bend, entered the stretch, had the rider flash the whip constantly from the right side from that juncture to the eighth pole and a little beyond, interrupted only by an occasional shot from the same side, drew well clear, swerved outward when given a solitary shot from the left side in the final seventy yards. CANDY KITTY slow to settle, was two wide at the top of the turn, was put to some light encouragement and started to pick up the pace, spun into the lane under stronger urging, angled out gradually until about five wide, the widest of all, with an eighth to go, kicked in with good energy after completing the maneuver to get up for the place. PREDICATE broke slightly to the outside, was pulled away from the nearest opponent in plenty of time to avoid any contact, got outstutled leaving the starting gate, saved ground until coming to the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward until three wide by the head of the stretch, arrived at the furlong marker as the closest pursuer of the top one, got outfinished in the late stages for the place. CHASE MY TAIL brushed at the start, chased the winner from the two path on the turn getting asked for run while undergoing the task, was put to a drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, folded. ALDARA made light contact with CHASE MY TAIL after lunging at the start, raced from off the inside on the turn, was already under a strong drive entering the stretch, made no headway. PALESTRINA three wide on the turn, gave way.
