PROFETIZA was conceded a clear advantage by MALIBU HOLIDAY shortly after the start, gradually worked her way over towards the rail, cut the pace, rated along, but kept at a slight distance from off the inside, felt the pressure intensifying late on the turn but remained under light encouragement until almost the eighth pole, responded positively when given her cue and kicked away. MALIBU HOLIDAY briefly on even terms with the winner during the initial stages, was eased back, prompted that rival from the two path, had LADY KIERKEGAARD arrive on the scene at the quarter pole, was under strong urging vying for command from between horses as the field headed into the stretch, proved no match, then just held on to the place. LADY KIERKEGAARD underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, missed out on second. THISIZSPARTA off the inside, paused at the five-sixteenths pole for a stride then was put to urging getting angled outward, commenced the stretch three wide, lacked the needed response. STREET CREW had a ground-saving journey, crept up into contention under light hand urging marking her way on the turn, spun into the lane and flattened out. ME MANDY swung four wide into the lane with no offering to give.
