MINISTER'S BID was rank in the gate, raced close up outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, dug in determinedly under steady pressure and prevailed after a long drive. RACKETEER was bumped after the start, pressed the pace from the outside and dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch. FLASHY BULL was bumped after the start, set the pace along the inside and stayed on stubbornly to the finish. ELEMENTS was outrun early, raced three wide and had no rally. TASTEYVILLE raced between rivals and tired. FOREST PHANTOM raced inside and tired.
