TIN CUP CHALICE recovered quickly after being bumped at the start, battled his way to the lead after going a quarter, continued to show the way while along the inside, entered the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, then turned back the closers while being kept busy to the wire. GROOMEDFORVICTORY reserved early, attempted a five wide rally, and finished with good energy. MEGAPIXEL raced wide and came home willingly. THAT'SRIGHTOFFICER bumped at the break, took the overland route during the run around the bend, flattened out during the final furlong. PEPPERONI saved ground and was outrun. BE BULLISH was knocked sideways at the start, sat well positioned along the inside, came up empty during the stretch drive. MOTOR PATROL came in, causing crowding at the start, chased wide until the top of the stretch and tired. HALF MOON STREET was bumped at the start, raced inside and gave way after going a half.
