CARMELLA CEE quickly cleared the competition under her own courage, drew out to a commanding advantage before completing the run around the bend, was put to brisk handling after entering the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of her biggest lead and safely maintained it, being kept busy to the end. WEAK DOLLAR POLICY chased the top one three wide on the turn, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, gained ground belatedly on the winner during the last eighth, while never posing a serious stretch threat. BUDDYS DREAM three wide entering the turn, cut the corner leaving it, altered course back to the outside coming to the three-sixteenths pole, and held well to take the show. SOUNDS FREUDIAN bobbled after the start and went on to best the rest. SOLDIERETTE three to four wide on the turn, tired. SWEETHEARTS KISS raced along the inside, was put to a long hard drive but made no headway on the top one. MONTESSORI placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no response to render. HOOKIN THE GOODS off the inside, displayed brief foot.
