SIR LESLIE settled in the middle of the field after the start, was mostly three wide on the full turn, picked up the pace after going halfway around, was already under encouragement turning for home four wide, got straightened away and took off in earnest after the front runners, closed in relentlessly, drew even with MIKE AND ROB past the the sixteenth pole, needed only a couple of more jumps to go by then edged away. MIKE AND ROB patiently stalked the loose leader from off the inside down the backstretch, began to close in on that rival coming to the end of the backstretch, was rated while prompting that rival from near the two path, arrived at the quarter pole and was turned loose, grabbed the lead in short order and kicked away, felt the winner's presence a short distance past the eighth pole, yielded in the final seventy yards but remained well in the clear for place honors. POST PATTERN underwent a three wide journey, issued a challenge for command coming to the quarter pole, stayed in contention for an additional furlong before flattening out. FACE THE RACE tucked along the rail well before departing the elbow chute, stayed the inside route thereafter, launched an abbreviated run from upper stretch to rally into a contending position with an eighth to go, but couldn't sustain it. PROFESSOR CHAOS got away awkwardly, raced at or near the rail for the opening three-quarters, moved outward until six wide by the top of the lane, finished well belatedly, but had to settle for minor spoils. CAT MAN FU strung out three wide on the chute, was mostly four wide on the full turn, entered the stretch one path wider still, lacked the needed response. KATMANSTU keen and pulling on the bit, made a three wide run to take the early advantage, spurted away to increase the margin between calls, was sent over just off the rail upon reaching the half mile pole, came under assault a furlong later and gave way. AWESOME HEART saved ground and faltered. JACK'S R WILD swung four wide into the stretch, had no rally. FIDDLERS TANGO took the inside route for nearly six furlongs, squeezed his way into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch and had no offering.
