SCHOOLYARD DREAMS loped early along down the backstretch, at a considerable margin behind the next to last opponent, scurried into contention with a sustained run from the two path on the turn, maintained the momentum entering the stretch, altered course to be five wide with a furlong remaining, closed in fast and with good energy on the leader, getting up with about two jumps to go to prove best. KINGSFORD DRIVE gave chase primarily three wide on the bend, tipped a bit wider to challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, took over during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in stubbornly but got reeled in. DIVINE MUSIC vied for control two wide, held on reasonably well for the show once displaced on the front end. ARCH TRAVELER cut the corner under a full drive, came up empty. SHANKOPOTAMUS bobbed after losing his footing at the start, was put to brisk encouragement and rushed up to join up with the early leader, that being the second place finisher, followed that rival closer to the rail all the while involved in a head to head tussle, was in the three path as the fight spilled over onto the bend, kept pace for nearly a half before backing away. STONECOLDSTEAMER swung five wide into the lane, had no response. DR. WESLEY underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, folded.
