COMES THE DREAM established the front crossing to the two path into the first turn while racing in hand, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths as IN ROCKY'S HONOR took closer order, got set down cutting the corner into the stretch, drifted to the two path straightened away, inched away to the eighth pole, drifted out under cross reined encouragement inside the final eighth while holding well to prevail kept to task. UNITARIAN just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide in upper stretch, offered up late foot to kick into contention inside the final sixteenth and secure the place honors. PARNELLI tracked inside settled in mid pack, shifted to the three path at the nine-sixteenths, got set down angling four wide for home, offered up a mild kick and just procured the show honors. RUNS LIKE A KITTEN just off the pace just off the inside, got let out cutting the corner into the stretch, appeared to want to angle out nearing the eighth pole but thought better of it, kept on mildly inside for the last major share. IN ROCKY'S HONOR three wide in close range in hand, came under coaxing and took closer order into the far turn, was put to a drive three furlongs out, spun three wide for home and weakened in the stretch. MR. JENNEY saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. POWERFUL broke in at the start, settled saving ground at the rear, became detached from the main body of the field nearing the half mile pole and trailed throughout.
