MIGHTY REWARD contently tracked the leader while sitting in the pocket, had the primary pursuer begin to fall back a short distance from the quarter pole and availing of the opportunity slipped into the two path, got let out and took control before completing the next furlong, kept well in the clear under good handling. PAN DULCE cut the corner into the lane, got angled outward almost immediately afterwards, came home with good energy to procure the place. CHESSRATE off the inside, unleashed four wide run past the three-eighths pole to close the gap, got placed five wide at the head of the stretch, rallied willingly to grab the show. GALWAY three wide at the top of the turn, closed in well en route for the last major check. LADY HALITE bumped with ABSOLUTE PARADISE at the start, raced three wide on the turn, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before flattening out. YOUR LION EYES hesitated at the start, quickly tucked along the rail and rode it for nearly a half, fanned outward until eight wide by the three-sixteenths pole, finished well

belatedly but with too much to do to seriously threaten. DADDY'S BIG GIRL in the five path for commencement of the stretch drive, had no rally. IT'S YOUR DIME away alertly, gained control, settled near the rail by the half mile pole, cut the pace from there under the attention of WICKED DISCO parked one path to the outside, had that rival back off only but gained no respite, getting pounced upon by the eventual winner in its stead, relinquished and backed away. HALO CITY GIRL off the inside, swung six wide into the lane, had no offering. BEBES PASSION saved ground to no avail. ABSOLUTE PARADISE bumped at the start, raced along the outside and failed to be a factor. WICKED DISCO fought with vigor against the bit in the early going, pressed the pacesetter from the two path for nearly a half, gave way, then was reported to have bled.
