NIGHT MANEUVER gave chase from the three path, got let out spinning into the stretch, closed in gradually and got up late. N. F.'S DESTINY showed the way from slightly off the rail, entered the stretch holding a comfortable advantage and got set down, emerged from the furlong grounds, having lost none if any of the lead, saw it steadily cut down thereafter and was caught a few strides before the end. WEE FREUDIAN chased the pacesetter from the two path, fell back slightly as the half was being completed, staged a mild comeback in the final furlong but without really threatening the top pair. POWER WORLD made sustained contact with UNCLE T SEVEN after coming out of the starting gate, was finally yanked off that rival, worked out a tuck into the pocket coming to the end of the backstretch, cut the corner into the lane, lacked the needed response. VEXOR bobbed slightly after losing his footing at the start, raced along the outside and was no factor. NOTMYFIRSTIME three wide and asked at the five-sixteenths marker, backed away. UNCLE T SEVEN squeezed at the start, was quickly sent over to the rail, rode it until the quarter pole, got taken outward after entering the lane until five to six wide with a furlong to go, made no headway. INFLATION TARGET bumped at the start, was under a snug hold taking the inside route around the bend, faltered.
