CRITICAL EYE was urged along to keep up early, came wide into the stretch, responded when roused, finished determinedly from the outside and was up in the final strides, driving. JOSTLE raced with the pace while in hand, rallied inside into the stretch and stayed on gamely to the wire. APPLE OF KENT raced close up while in hand, angled out into the stretch and stayed gamely, her rider losing his whip in deep stretch. SERRA LAKE was outrun along the inside early, rallied inside turning for home and finished well. DARLING MY DARLING was hustled along early, raced wide throughout and had no response when roused. CRESCENT COAST chased the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch. BEAUTIFUL PLEASURE quickly showed in front, set the pace for three quarters and drifted out while tiring in the stretch.
