JUNE THE TIGER broke slowly, was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and drew clear late. TIP CITY stumbled after the start, raced three wide and dug in gamely in the stretch. SIR PYY raced close up early and finished well inside. STOP THE RACE raced close up outside, put in a wide run nearing the stretch and tired in the final furlong. TIPPER raced inside and was not a factor. GROUND GAME had no rally. RATIONALEXUBERANCE contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. VICARIOUSLY had no response when roused. FAST MARKET contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. IMAGE OF GOLD raced inside and tired.
