GANTRY settled into midpack soon after the start, crept up towards the front runners from along the hedge on the turn, was put to encouragement angling outward for the stretch drive, took over a few strides past the eighth pole and kicked clear under a brisk hand ride. HIGHER COURT bobbled right out of the starting gate, wasted no time to grab the front, motored around the turn slightly off the hedge cutting a fast clip, was let out after entering the stretch, still held the advantage with a furlong remaining, but with the top one making his presence by this station, succumbed to that opponent soon afterwards but continued onward with good courage to garner place honors. ARNELL in hand at the break, brought up the back of the pack for nearly a half, moved up into contention cutting the corner into the lane, failed to gain any additional ground departing the eighth pole, but held well enough to secure the show. NEW YAWKER placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, had no rally. DUKE OF NAPLES raced along the outside, was urged along chasing the pacesetter, gave way after completing a half. AMERICAN CLASSIC saved ground and faltered. OPENING MOVE in the three path by midpoint on the turn, folded.
