Footnotes

WON FAST BULLET rubbed shoulders with JOKER JACK at the start, moved up into a forward position, disputed the pace from the four path between rivals during the run around the bend, got turned loose as the field headed into the lane, dueled with the runner up the entire length of the stretch, grabbed a narrow advantage and dug in with good determination to preserve it. MOUNT KARAKORUM away with no apparent mishap, raced in the two path and at times a bit beyond until the quarter pole, argued for control as the innermost member of a foursome, got called upon entering the stretch, held his ground stubbornly during the ensuing furlong, yielded reluctantly in the last eighth pole but continued on gamely to preserve the place. MORE THAN A REASON chased the disputed pace three wide around the turn, took the five path for entrance into the lane, mustered up a mild stretch response to grab the show. JOKER JACK made light contact with the winner at the start, cruised up down the backstretch to make his presence felt by the half mile pole, took the overland route contesting the pace with three others, fell back slightly just before reaching the end of the turn and tired. STAR DANCE M D raced three wide while vying for command from between opponents, ducked closer to the rail in upper stretch but soon flattened out. FULTON STREET saved ground throughout, the member of the field to spend significant time along the inside, tracked the fighting foursome spread outward from the two path just up ahead under some coaxing, had STAR DANCE M D angle into the two path in upper stretch, was hesitant to make a rail bid, idling behind the aforementioned rival for a good furlong down the road, altered course in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole to no avail. TROPONIN trailed.
