MAD BOMBER initially reserved midpack, came under hand urging at the nine-sixteenths to close in on the front, steadily progressed on that goal through the turn continuing the prolonged drive, confronted the leader swinging from the three path for home, battled through the length of the stretch determinedly widening away from the rest, wore down his main foe to take command at the sixteenth pole digging in to prevail. MR COWBOY broke out at the start bumping JAKE'S SHAKE lightly, set the pace under reserve from just off the inside in the two path, got confronted nearing the head of the stretch and was set down in response, fought on stubbornly through the lane, succumbed the front at the sixteenth pole settling for the place honors well clear of the rest. MIKE AND ROB tracked the front from midpack down along the rail, was pushed along from the half mile pole, swung four wide at the quarter pole, offered up enough while weakening to be along for show honors. CAT MAN FU broke in at the start bumping JAKE'S SHAKE before being taken off that rival, raced just off the pace while four wide through the turn, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home and tired. IMASPEEDYGUY unhurried at the rear, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, passed tired foes through the lane. KNOCK QUIETLY raced towards the rear while four wide and never menaced. JAKE'S SHAKE bumped on both sides at the start, attended the pace from the three path for a half and wilted.
