### Footnotes

SAILMATE allowed to settle early on, made progress on the front before being urged at the three-eighths pole, swung three to four wide for home, offered up a good kick through the lane steadily eating away at the leader's margin to just get up and prevail on the line. SHREWD ONE reserved off the pace initially, made progress under his own power three wide to range up and seize command at the three-eighths pole, remained unhurried until straightening for home and with the aforementioned rival gaining momentum in behind, was let out drawing away to a safe margin with an eighth go, kicked on willingly to the wire widening away in tandem with the eventual winner from the rest before getting nailed in the last jump while well clear for the place honors. PERSONAL STRIKE raced in midpack, was asked to close in at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide for home, kicked on mildly for the show honors while never threatening the top. VEE'S ACCOLADE raced three wide in the turn from towards the rear, was placed to a drive at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home offering up a mild bid for the last major share. HOW DO I WIN hustled from the start, came under light urging to set the pace while in the two path, got displaced on the front at the three-eighths pole and steadily faded from contention. SHANKOPOTAMUS urged along between rivals in midpack, swung four wide at the quarter pole and made no late headway. TRICKY HAT (CHI) chased from the two path towards the rear, offered no rally when called upon midway on the turn. COLOSSAL GIFT out hustled in the early going, was under a busy hand ride from the nine-sixteenths, saved ground throughout and never factored. TROUBLE IN DODGE prompted the pace while two to three wide for a half and gave way.
