Footnotes

TOWERING MOON got off to a sluggish start, darted over to the inside and hugged the rail for the rest of the way, bided time under a firm hold on the turn and bit beyond, arrived at the three-sixteenths pole and was let out, responded positively to the calling, surged past the front runners in the final seventy yards to prove best. SLOT PLAY three wide at midpoint on the turn, drafted behind cover, paused before entering the stretch, swung six wide and mustered up a strong kick en route for the place. DREAMSGONEWILD made light contact with PLEASURE PRINCIPLE, left the three-eighths pole three wide, came home with good energy to take the show. COUNTKNICKERBOCKER stalked the front runners four wide for nearly a half, worked out a tuck one path closer to the rail after another began to drop back, stayed in the thick of things to near the sixteenth pole before flattening out. SUNLOVER raced near the two path, picked up the pace noticeably nearing the quarter pole, was checked when coming up fast into some potential traffic prior to entering the stretch, got going properly a sixteenth later, angled outward gradually and gained ground belatedly. VISIONANDAPRAYER grabbed the advantage soon after the start, was lightly coaxed while showing the way from the inside, got called upon for the stretch, held his ground well during the run through the furlong grounds, got reeled in by a host of rivals leaving the sixteenth pole. HALF WILDCAT chased from the two path, was already under solid encouragement spinning into the lane, had no rally. RICO CAPOTE tracked the front runners from the pocket, got asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, came up

empty. BIG CITY BOY broke at a considerable distance behind the penultimate breaker after being released by the assistant starter well after the others were, loped primarily two wide for the opening half, came three wide into the stretch and made no impact. PLEASURE PRINCIPLE bumped lightly at the start, pressed the issue from the two path for about a half before giving way. THE BIG DELUXE raced three wide as a forward factor until the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
