QUIET CALLER quickly established a clear lead, was left alone through rather ordinary fractions and had enough left to hold on for the win. ELIZA'S KISS raced closest to the winner from start to finish. RAY OF HAPPINESS, rated along early, finished with good courage. JUMP ROPE, rated along early, finished with good courage. SHERO was hard-held inside and posed no threat during the running. LADY CLUE was taken back and was never a factor. TIA'S HALO, rated along early, had no impact on the outcome. GOLD NECKLACE was taken back in the early going and raced wide. HOLY BOLLA was rated along inside and tired.
