EXPECT NOTHING raced close up outside while in hand, rallied three wide to the front entering the stretch, dug in determinedly in the drive and got the nod for the score. GEBB'S DIXIE was outrun early, rallied nearing the stretch, dug in gamely while between rivals and just missed. LADY NELSON raced in hand early, rallied three wide and finished gamely outside. WITHORWITHOUTYOU chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. LA TINA was outrun early, raced inside, split rivals and offered a mild rally inside. SEA MISTRESS pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SOUTH WING set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ARCHERS GAL raced wide and tired.
