Footnotes

QUIET ON THE TEE unhurried for six furlongs while racing three wide, was asked for a bit more midway around the far turn, rallied in earnest when put to encouragement after turning for home, made up ground rapidly with every stride, grabbed the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then finished with determination to preserve the decision. STORM HOPE took the inside route, found room to swing outward nearing the top of the stretch, was caught behind traffic at the three-sixteenths pole, altered course outward after spotting clearance at the eighth pole and came home with good courage to grab place honors. PLAYFUL MAJESTY outrun early, raced four wide around the far turn, found himself six deep at the top of the lane, and rallied with good energy to be along late for the show. COPS FEVER stalked the leaders three wide, swung into action heading for the stretch, gained a slim lead nearing the furlong grounds, stubbornly resisted all challengers until the sixteenth pole before yielding command. PERNICE steadied between rivals approaching the opening turn, was unhurried while placed a firm hold, continued to bide her time during the run around the second bend, was forced to remain on hold from the quarter pole until the three-sixteenths pole while lacking smooth sailing, gained the needed room soon afterwards and displayed good late foot. COUGH DROP within striking distance, lacked the necessary stretch response. DON'T YOU LINGER vied along the outside for the lead, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before weakening. J L BERNSTEIN bumped right after the start, was steadied along the during the run towards the first turn, failed to reach a contending position. JOHN WYATT was through after going six furlongs. MIND BOGGLING fought for the lead along the inside until upper stretch and gave way. DONTSTEALMYLAND lunged at the break, exchanged bumps with a rival soon after the start, was steadied along the inside during the run to the opening turn, raced along the inside, steadied once more when a rival ducked inward nearing the quarter pole, then lacked any offering after entering the stretch.
