CARMEN'S KISS away from the starting gate in good order, was unhurried during the opening stages while saving ground, made a quick move, angling around the leader just past the quarter pole to take charge, opened up a sizeable advantage with a furlong remaining and continued to increase her winning margin under a drive. SARAH'S SALLY took the inside route, swung wide into the stretch, couldn't keep pace with the winner during the stretch run but continued on well to garner place honors. RNBS BLACKWATEROLL steadied slightly after the break, raced off the rail, displayed a mild rally to be along for the show. CAT GRACE took command soon after the start, set the pace towards the inside for a half, was unable to muster up any resistance when the top one launched her bid in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. CRAFTY GEM, broke through the gate prior to the start, was no factor. MISS SAUL broke slowly and failed to reach a contending position. QUANTIFIER hesitated at the start, improved her position after turning for home by outkicking mainly weak rivals. FLASHY AND FAST forwardly placed until upper stretch, tired. COTTAGE INDUSTRY was through after going a half. JACKPOT JULIE raced wide and faded.
