TYPHOON TYCOON took the inside route around the opening bend, was taken outward midway down the backstretch, sat reserved, well spotted until the quarter pole, rallied in earnest once called upon, closed readily during the run through the furlong grounds, rallied past the leader with good speed to take command just past the sixteenth pole and edged clear, while being kept busy to the end. MORETHAN FOURHOURS unhurried while racing along the inside, moved up into a good striking position with a solid bid after entering the far turn, lost none of her momentum after cutting the corner into the stretch, angled outward immediately in anticipation of sufficient racing clearance, saw the plans foiled when caught in traffic coming to the eighth pole, altered course back inward, split rivals in deep stretch and came home with good energy, too late. BUDGET three wide around the second turn, finished willingly to grab the show. REMITTANCE prompted the leader from the outside while keeping something in reserve, gained a short advantage nearing the furlong marker, only to weaken thereafter. BOLD VINDICATION rated on the rail while cutting the fractions for three-quarters, gave way. ECRU EGRET the first to pop out of the starting gate, dropped back in a hurry soon afterwards, chose the four path to make her run around the second bend, lacked a rally once the stretch drive began. MARSCAPONI within range for six furlongs, was asked for a response on the far turn, faded.
