GREEN ARROWS within range off the inside, was coaxed along on the turn to maintain position, swung four wide into the lane, rallied in earnest when asked, worked her way to the front leaving the furlong grounds and held sway. AURIC GIRL reserved during the initial half, fanned five to six wide into the stretch, bumped with POSEY PARK after that rival swerved out a bit soon after turning for home, then finished with good energy down the outside of the course to garner place honors. POSEY PARK reserved early, was strung out five to six wide entering the stretch, swerved outward when a rival veered over in upper lane, bumped with the runner up as a result, continued on home with a good kick to grab the show. TREAT HER RIGHT contested the pace from the outside, advanced when ready to take over as the field turned for home, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, but failed to sustain the move, getting outkicked during the final furlong. MSJERSEYROULETTE rode the rail during the early stages, was eased outward after entering the turn, was stacked very wide at the head of the stretch, steadied when AURIC GIRL was carried outward in upper stretch, altered course to the inside soon

afterwards, made good progress during the run through the furlong grounds, changed course back to the outside at the sixteenth pole, with traffic starting to form in front, then continued on willingly to earn a major share of the purse. MISS TEQUILA vied inside for the lead and gave way in upper stretch. NATURAL MATCH, broke open the gate prior to the start, came out in good order at the break, was guided over to the rail, saved ground until the quarter pole, made a mild bid until the eighth pole, before flattening out. WYNOT SIYUE off sluggishly, was no factor. LADY VALIANT was outrun. HOOKIN THE GOODS tracked the front runners from the pocket, angled into the three path turning for home but came up empty when called upon. MIRRORS N SMOKE chased from the outside, was pushed out by a pair of faster moving rivals, just to the inside of her, as that trio spun into the lane, unintentionally instigating the chain reaction of trouble soon to follow, tired steady thereafter.
