Footnotes

DECENNIAL raced four deep in midpack while well rated, got released from the grip at the five-sixteenths moving into contention swinging four wide for home, unleashed a good kick to move into contention and seize command with a furlong remaining, inched off with a host in behind under a drive, dug in repulsing the challenge down inside nearing the wire to hold and prevail. SCENARIO ANALYSIS just off the pace initially in the two path, skimmed the rail through the turn, cut the corner into the lane placed to encouragement, kicked on well in the final eighth for place honors, not having enough to collar the aforementioned rival while safe for place. CENTRINA raced four wide towards the rear, availed of the opportunity to slip in a path through the turn, swung four to five wide for home commencing a drive, kicked on with good energy belatedly to garner the show over a trio battling on to her inside. THE WEST RIM three wide just off the pace, was let out at the five-sixteenths while in the two path, kicked on with good energy while in contention through the lane but

was outfinished by the top three. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER under reserve four wide in close range, was let out spinning for home and seized command briefly at the head of the stretch, got headed at the eighth pole and was out kicked thereafter despite continuing on well to the wire. BOBS PINUP GIRL saved ground throughout travelling in midpack, was roused at the head of the lane, offered up a mild kick through the stretch. TAKE HER TOTHE TOP raced three to four wide, was let out at the five-sixteenths and never reached contention. YES SHE RULES broke in at the start and was corrected before contact could made with her inside rival, raced initially three deep towards the rear, opted to the rail into the far turn, came under a busy ride at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. CLASSICAL FASHION attended the pace three wide, was set down at the quarter pole, remained prominent until the final furlong and weakened in the lane. NIKKI'S NUT reserved on the lead while just off the inside, was let out nearing the turn for home, got overhauled at that station and steadily gave way through the lane. MUSICAL RAIN (IRE) sluggish at the start, was outrun in the early going, had the rider put her to a protective hold at the five-eighths pole, was pulled up and subsequently vanned off.
