SPEEDY'S GAL secured the pocket, got to within striking distance of the former loose leader by the end of the backstretch, remained on hold throughout the run around the far turn, spun into the stretch with an available opening along the rail and availed of the fortuitous situation, duelled with the runner up down the lane, edged away in the last sixteenth, driving. LA BILLOS broke on top and easily secured the lead, was guided over to the inside, sped off to her lonesome self in the initial stages under her own power against the well rated competition at that stage, got latched onto about midway on the second turn, drifted slightly outward entering the stretch, exposing the inside, and was called upon, got pounced upon by the eventual winner shortly into the stretch run and soon yielded the advantage to that rival, fought with vigor until the sixteenth pole attempting to re claim it, couldn't, but continued on willingly en route for the place. DATTTTS APPEALING took the inside route, loosely followed the winner after turning for home, changed course by angling outward in mid lane,

got outfinished. ONTHEKISSER saved ground, launched a mild rail rally for the last major award. PROUD SIREN underwent a three to four wide journey, lacked the necessary stretch response. ST. LUCY between rivals for a good portion of the opening three-quarters, had no rally. SARATOGA BOUND raced three wide around both turns, remained a forward factor until the furlong grounds before backing away. UPTOWN GIRL (BRZ) between rivals on the far turn, came up empty for the stretch run. ZELLWEGER strung out in the three path on each bend, was taken outward a bit more in upper stretch, failed to reach a contending position. OUR FAVORITE stalked from off the inside, moved up to increase the pressure coming to the five-sixteenths pole, tired. THE WINGED VENUS raced three wide on the second turn, was through after going six furlongs. SOME LEGEND hesitated at the break, was on the receiving end of three hard right shots in rapid succession as motivation to get going, lagged off the back of the pack for nearly a half, left the backstretch from the three path, responded momentarily when asked for some run at three-eighths pole, but had little left by upper stretch.
