WILLY BEAMIN broke on top, was immediately put to some light urging as he dropped back just about quickly into midpack, was kept to some mild encouragement while keeping a watchful eye on the pressured pacesetter from off the inside, got let out a notch at the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and was put to much stronger handling, angled sharply into the three path during the initial portion of the stretch drive, closed in readily on the front runners, collared the embattled pair in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew well clear, driving. BRIGAND was knocked sideways slightly after bumping with EVEN GOT QUIET at the start, moved up to grab the front soon afterwards and tucked along the rail, felt the presence of coupled entry mates, one applying pressure directly to the outside and the other sitting within striking distance from the pocket, had the latter range up to apply pressure of his own coming to the five-sixteenths marker just as the former was backing away, got set down to a drive at that station, was still a body length to the good arriving at the furlong marker with a revved up WILLY BEAMIN bearing down hard on both front runners, got reeled in by the aforementioned opponent a sixteenth down the road, went on to win the battle for place honors. NIGHT MANEUVER secured the pocket soon after the start, tracked the leader from there with the rider applying stout restraint, sat contently until leaving the midway point on the turn, angled outward and split rivals to take on BRIGAND during the later stages of the run around the bend, got engaged in a stretch long duel but came up short. QUIET FAVORITE slipped off the inside near the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. THE PRIZE FIGHTER broke open the gate after making solid contact with it, thrashed about before settling back down, came away with no apparent mishap as the field was sent off and running in short order, pressed the issue from the two path down the backstretch and until the five-sixteenths pole, drifted outward at that juncture while weakening, opening an avenue of opportunity for his stable mate, steadily tired. SWAG DADDY raced along the outside, got placed four wide at the head of the stretch, came up empty. EVEN GOT QUIET bumped with runner up at the start, was coaxed along from the three path on the turn, folded.
