OUCHY NIGHT was urged to take the early lead, continued on the front while facing mild pressure from RED SEVEN, disposed of that rival when asked for a response after turning for home, entered the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage then held sway while being kept busy to the end. SNEAKIN UP raced between rivals within striking distance of the leaders on the turn, proved no match for top one during the stretch drive, but finished willingly to garner place honors. STUNNING ELECTRA bobbled at the break, saved ground until angling out at the quarter pole, lacked the needed rally. DOROTHY'S ESSENSE bumped at the start, was never a threat. HELEN'S LADY was steadied while racing greenly during the early stages of the event. BEBOBLUES ART took the overland route and gave way. RED SEVEN pressed the pacesetter while wide for a half and faltered. DANCING DAISY was no factor. JUSTIFY bumped at the break, was outrun.
