DREAMS GALLORE, in hand on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn, moved quickly from the outside entering the stretch, drew clear then widened while being shown the whip through the final furlong. OH WHAT A WINDFALL showed speed from the outside while in hand, raced four wide on the turn, could not stay with the winner in the stretch but continued on well to secure the place award. BETTER THAN HONOUR showed good speed while in hand, moved three wide between rivals to gain a short lead leaving the backstretch, continued on well, into the stretch but weakened in the drive. MADISON'S CHARM, under stout restraint early on, pulled her way up along the inside on the backstretch but came up empty when asked for run. PRECIOSA V. showed speed for a half mile, stopped and was eased in the stretch. TUTORIAL tired badly and was eased in the stretch. THREE RING was injured in the paddock and was scratched by the stewards.
