MISSINGLISALEWIS three wide around the opening bend, was maneuvered over to the two path soon after entering the backstretch, assuming the role of stalker, kept a watchful eye on the leader while not being asked for his best, felt encouragement for the initial time nearing the head of the stretch, rallied readily, resisted the left handed pressure being applied, momentarily lugging in coming to the eighth pole, brushing with LUBASH as a result, got put back on a truer course in short order, then finished with determination to take over the lead and edge away. FRESHMAN DORM saved ground under a firm hold during the opening stages, slipped outward during the run around the second bend, paused briefly behind a bit of traffic approaching the quarter pole, chose to angle out to the three path turning for home, commenced his rally after being straightened away and finished with good energy to garner place honors. BRITISH BANKER raced along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive, beginning midway around the far turn, fanned four wide into the lane, then continued onward mildly to be along for the show. LUBASH rode the pocket until the quarter pole, closed willingly after being set down, to draw on even terms with the pacesetter, being joined at the same time on the outside by the top one, brushed with that foe after being put in somewhat tight quarters between rivals at the furlong marker, failed to sustain the move thereafter, steadily weakening. ASPIRE TO SILVER overcame a bad stumble at the start to take command, was rated on the lead towards the inside, met stiff pressure for the first turn in upper stretch, offered resistance for the next furlong before backing off. DANTASTIC off the inside, was never involved.
