Footnotes

RAPID MON pursued the pacesetter from the three path, ranged up to that rival from the five-sixteenths pole, poked a head in front as that duo turned for home, lengthened out to a comfortable advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, then dug in under strong handling to safely turn back a pair of late-closing rivals. ELTISH STAR contently rode the rail, unhurried, slipped outward near the five-sixteenths pole, swung three wide heading into the stretch, finished with good late kick down the outside of the strip to take place honors. KILN CREEK raced along the outside and came home willingly en route for the show. UNBRIDLED DANGER took the inside route, moved into contention, still clinging to the rail, leaving the half mile pole, while not being asked for his best, was put to a drive prior to swinging outward in upper stretch, but flattened out during the stretch drive. KHAN OF KHANS broke open the gate prior to the start, proceeded to bobble at the break, wasted little time recovering, establishing command soon afterwards, cut the pace on the inside, was confronted by the top one approaching the quarter pole, readily gave up the front, and steadily tired thereafter. FRENCH TRANSITION raced three wide and was outrun. MY DADDIO forwardly placed, was through after a half.
