CITY STRUT grabbed the lead soon after departing the gate, showed the way, being rated along the inside for the opening half, was put to a drive entering the stretch, gradually increased the advantage down the lane, being kept busy to the end. DON'T CROSS ME saved ground around the bend, rallied well enough to get up for the place. ALL CLASS patiently tracked the top one sitting a pocket trip, found room and was placed into the two path just before reaching the top of the stretch, displayed greenness throughout the stretch run, lugged inward soon after settling into the lane, was given some stick work from the left side and placed back on a straighter course, appeared to be moving well when he lugged inward a second time, near the eighth pole, after receiving a solitary shot from the right side, went onward a short distance before again, through the efforts of the rider, resuming a truer course, then lugged in for the third and final time at the sixteenth pole. WINLOC'S JOHN LEE rated kindly between rivals, lacked the necessary stretch response. COOL OPERATOR stalked the leader from the outside, was asked for some run to keep pace in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole before backing away. KOMISAREK raced along the outside and was no factor. MARMALADE SKY underwent a ground-saving journey, was put to a prolonged drive, commencing from the half mile pole, came up empty. KNOCK QUIETLY three wide, was through after completing a half.
