FEROCIOUS WON was steadied along while being rated, continued to bide his time while still not being asked for his best after entering the stretch, was finally given his cue nearing the eighth pole, responded willingly, going past the leader shortly after leaving the furlong marker, then edged away under good handling. COOL N COLLECTIVE content to race within striking distance along the outside, advanced readily toward the the leader after entering the turn, had no trouble displacing that rival, headed to the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, was joined by the winner shortly afterwards, proved no match but continued on well to garner place honors. INTIMIDATING saved ground throughout. SIPHO shot out of the starting gate to take the lead, failed to protect it when COOL N COLLECTIVE drew alongside midway on the turn despite strong encouragement, and steadily tired thereafter. TARAKAN never menaced. READY ENOUGH widest on the turn, offered little. STATESMAN had brief speed, was pulled up after going a quarter and was vanned off.
