SEYOUATSERGIOS set the pace off the rail for a half, opened a clear advantage at the top of the stretch, maintained a clear advantage into deep stretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. COME SOON (URU) settled in good position, rallied along the rail nearing the quarter pole, angled out while rallying in midstretch and was gradually getting to the winner at the finish. PSYCHOTIC SUMMER checked in tight and and pinched back at the start, raced well back, split horses on the turn and finished willingly. LOFTY BANNER steadied after stumbling at the start, was outrun for a half, circled five wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. ALPHA DANCER pressed the pace between horses and drifted out while giving way at the quarter pole. PASSING DREAM chased four wide early and gave way on the turn.
